EXERCISES

Technical Exercise: Pattern (F# major)
Flexibility: Remington Slurring Pattern
Tuning: C4 tuned to unison, major 3rd,
minor 3rd, and perfect 5th
Range (low): descending tetrachord,
hold final pitch 3 seconds
Range (high): ascending tetrachord, hold
final pitch 4 seconds

PROCESS

Each competitor will compete in only 5 events, with points being given. Judges TBA.

- 1 point for competing
- 2 points for 3rd place
- 3 points for 2nd place
- 4 points for 1st place

The highest point place takes 2nd toss (ulrican gets first toss, as it's his horn), and the high point winner earns both the horn and timeless glory.
