EXERCISES

Technical Exercise: Pattern (F# major)
Flexibility: Remington Slurring Pattern
Tuning: C4 tuned to unison, major 3rd,
minor 3rd, and perfect 5th
Range (low): descending tetrachord,
hold final pitch 3 seconds
Range (high): ascending tetrachord, hold
final pitch 4 seconds

PROCESS

Each competitor will compete in only 5 events, with points being given. Judges TBA.

- 1 point for competing
- 2 points for 3rd place
- 3 points for 2nd place
- 4 points for 1st place

The high scorer before the toss event gets the 1st toss.

The final winner gets the horn and timeless glory. And the modern art trombone.
